

Elite Fire RMS



OVERVIEW

The Elite Fire Module is the state offered solution for fire department record management. Formerly known as TEMSIS, the New Hampshire Emergency Services Reporting system - or NHESR - now combines NFIRS compliant reporting with the state's existing EMS reporting system for a combined Emergency Medical and Fire Services reporting-solution. This cloud-based statewide software is offered as the result of a contract with ImageTrend, guaranteeing no-cost use of all major fire modules through 2028 (*exceptions are noted below*).

This web-based software is supplied by ImageTrend, the same vendor who supplies our EMS software.

NHESR allows for seamless integration of fire and EMS data:

- Fire Module and TEMSIS share the same website, login, and interface.
- Already documenting EMS runs in TEMSIS? The Fire module can be accessed directly from the EMS form, streamlining documentation of these incidents.

Enclosed within this document is an overview of the modules which are available in the suite, as well as any associated cost for these modules.

- Most modules, including the core NFIRS reporting software, are included at no cost.

- Contact ImageTrend Sales for a quote for these optional modules
 - Mobile Inspections
 - Agency level validations
EMS and Fire validation modules sold separately.
- ImageTrends "Slate" staff scheduling system – Integrated with NHESR daily rosters
- Integration with other scheduling / HR software –contact ImageTrend to see if supported

FIRE INCIDENT REPORTING HIGHLIGHTS

The core Fire Incident Reporting form is managed at the state level.

Fire form is designed and maintained with continuous input from New Hampshire fire services to meet local and state needs and NFIRS requirements

NFIRS compliant software which allows for responsive documenting of incidents.

All NFIRS fields are included

Customizable by the state to allow for an adaptive workflow

- Only the NFIRS modules which are required for a given incident type are shown

Run form design, workflow and validation rules customized to a specific service can only be accomplished by the service purchasing and managing the Elite product for themselves: Typical cost of \$6,000-\$10,000 depending on call volume.

Can be integrated with CAD to import any reportable field from your dispatch into the incident.

- Additional cost of \$1,000 per year

Streets and Highways can be standardized for easy selection and documentation, or entered as free text.

The Apparatus Power Tool allows for easy documenting of all apparatus and personnel on a scene, including primary assignments and hours worked.

For any data you want to collect that goes beyond NFIRS, supplemental questions can be created and added to the report.

- Alternatively, entire worksheets can be created to document data not otherwise collected in the base form.

Can be automatically scheduled and assigned to personnel, units, or stations

Can automatically notify you if a checklist is completed, if a negative response is given, or if a note is made

CQI

Can create filters to automatically be presented with the type of runs you want to CQI
 CQI Form manager can be customized so you only see the information you want, and have it presented in the format you prefer
